1. **The YUT-C 50K/25K** has far surpassed any previous year regarding the number of registered runners. There are now over 120 registered for the two events this Saturday. Race starts at 8 AM. "Riverview Rd is now completely open now I could use about 15 volunteers to handle the half and 10K runners as they will still be pretty tightly packed because it's the first water station from the start line.

I'll also be asking those volunteers to go to Boston Store finish line after the runners pass because they should be done in no time. The Riverview Rd water station is located on Riverview Rd at the little picnic area just south of Snowville Rd.

I also have Oak hill open now and I only need about 5-6 volunteers at that location to service the marathoners on the way down and back.

3. The **Inaugural Bobcat Trail Marathon's** registration is gaining speed! As a 2010 part of the WRTR Race Series, please help us spread the word and celebrate a successful 2009 by traveling down to Burr Oak State Park in Glouster, OH and running in this inaugural event.
